SUBJECT: NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

- a. Students who live outside the supervisory district shall be called "non-resident students."
- b. Students who reside outside the supervisory district and desire to attend BOCES classes shall initiate all contacts with BOCES through school district officials of their home school district. Any authorization for non-resident attendance must carry the approval of the local school district and the local BOCES in which the residence is located.
- c. Non-resident tuition shall be established by the District Superintendent and shall be approved by the Board of Cooperative Educational Services.
- d. Students who move out of the BOCES boundaries during the school year may be given permission to complete that year in attendance at BOCES at no additional charge.
