SUBJECT: STUDENT BEHAVIOR

Students shall conform to the rules and regulations of the school, shall obey reasonable directions of teachers and administrators, shall be orderly and considerate in conduct, shall be neat and clean in dress and person, shall exercise proper care in the use of textbooks, supplies and equipment, and shall refrain from damaging property of the school district, of BOCES and of others.

The teacher should resolve any minor problems that may arise with students in class. Teachers are instructed to contact their administrators or building principal in the event of serious behavior problems. In crises, where time is essential, the building principal should take whatever action is appropriate to resolve an emergency situation. In cases of Special Education students, the Special Education Division should be notified of the action taken.

The building principal and other administrative staff are available to the teacher in the event of a major crisis in behavior that necessitates supervisory intervention. Minor or "normal" crises, as well as emergencies of various types, should be handled by the building principal or the home school principal if appropriate.

It is the responsibility of the building principal to notify the home school of any problem or crisis affecting students.
