Possession or Use of a Weapon on School Property Policy # 6250, 2.5

SUBJECT: POSSESSION OR USE OF A WEAPON ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

The possession or use of a weapon will not be permitted on the grounds of the school district, except those weapons required by law officers on duty, military personnel on duty, or those required for instructors or students in an approved educational program when specifically approved by the director of the division. This policy shall apply to all persons on school property including school employees and visitors as well as students.

The Penal Code of the State of New York shall be used to determine what must be considered a weapon.

Any student found violating these rules may be subject to program exclusion and the student's parent(s)/legal guardian shall be notified of the weapon(s) taken from the student. The police will be notified of any confiscated weapons.
